


MASTER OF EUROPEAN STUDIES



The curriculum is designed as a program with three main disciplines that make typical teaching subjects at European universities, specifically **political science, economics and law.**

APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT

Candidates for the enrollment to the Master of European Studies **do not take entrance exams.**

Candidates need to meet following conditions:

- 4 –year B.A. degree in social sciences and humanities (equivalent of 240 ECTS)
- Applicants who finished their 4 –year B.A. degree in social sciences and humanities abroad need to have a certified copy of a diploma (Validated by the University of Zagreb). We accept applications with confirmation issued by the Ured za akademsko priznavanje inozemnih visokoškolskih kvalifikacija Sveučilišta u Zagrebu (Office for academic recognition of foreign higher education qualifications of the University of Zagreb), that the request for the recognition of diploma was submitted by the student.
- Proficiency in English

Documents to be submitted:

- Cover letter in English
- CV in English
- 2 academic letters of recommendation
- Certified copy of a diploma
- Grade transcript
- Contact address and phone number

Applications will be ranked based on the undergraduate study grade point average. Enrollment quota is 20 regular and 10 foreign students.

Tuition fee is 7.500,00 HRK per semester (total fee is 15.000 HRK).

Applications will be accepted on 17 and 18 September 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Please submit the filled forms at the Faculty Secretariat (Tajništvo) along with the necessary documents stated in the application form. Forms and documents can also be submitted by post dated September 18, 2020 at the following address: Faculty of Political Sciences, Lepušićeva 6, 10000 Zagreb, with the annotation: for the Master of European Studies.

Preliminary rankings will be announced on September 21, 2020.

Written complaints on the preliminary rankings can be filed within 24 hours of the date of publication in the Faculty Secretariat. After the appeals procedure is completed, the final rankings are published.
