

- GUIDELINES FOR REVIEWERS -

Annals of the Croatian Political Science Association publish only manuscripts that undergo a rigorous international double-blind peer review and have received a positive review by at least two reviewers. Submitted articles should not be published before (neither partially nor completely, or in different language), nor should currently be considered for publication by any other journal or book. Authors are responsible for the paper authorship.

With the exception of online first publication, the Annals are published annually, in December of the ongoing year. All manuscripts submitted by no later than October will be processed and reviewed for the pending volume. Manuscript have to be in line with the journal's focus and scope and fulfill all technical requirements within the guidelines for authors, on illustrations, referencing, etc. Criteria for judging a submission's suitability for publication in this journal are following.

- 1) Manuscript meets the general criteria of scientific significance and excellence.
- Manuscript contributes to understanding and explanation of politics, the development of political science and its subdiciplines, either from the perspective of political science itself or from the perspective of other scientific fields.
- Manuscript communicates with relevant and current discussions within the field of political science and its subdiciplines or with the discussion on the relation between political science and other scientific disciplines.
- 4) Manuscript has a clear, logical and coherent structure with standard and informative introduction and conclusion.
- 5) Manuscript takes into account all relevant sources and literatures for the examined topic, references are up-to-date and evidence is presented in a clear and precise manner.
- 6) Wording and writing style of the manuscript is fluent and reader-friendly.
- 7) Manuscript follows all technical instructions of the journal, especially on length and referencing.
- 8) Manuscript is coherent with the main ethical principles of conducting research.
