- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

This Agreement shall be effective for the period 2015-2021. If either institution wishes to terminate the agreement, one year's notice must be given in writing. For example, notice to terminate mobility from 2015/16 must be given by 1 September 2014. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
