## Inter-institutional agreement 2014-21 between programme countries

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. The sending university will screen and select candidates for exchange studies in accordance with its applicable rules and regulations. The candidates of the contracting institutions will use the required application form of the receiving institution. The receiving institution will accept the candidates selected by the sending institution if mutually acceptable academic and/or professional qualifications and standards are met. However, the receiving university has the right to make the final decision on the admission of candidates nominated for exchange. Admission to a specific course is subject to the exchange student being satisfactorily qualified for the chosen area of study and/or course level, and availability.

The exchange students will be subject to the laws and regulations of the country and the university where the student is currently studying or is under direct supervision.

#### E. Calendar

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 10 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 10 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Any exchange in progress will continue until completed. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

Swedish grades are normally awarded on a basis of 3 grades; Pass with distinction (VG or Väl godkänd), Pass (G or Godkänd) or Fail (U or Underkänd). However, some faculties make use of a different grading scale:

-At the joint Faculties of Humanities and Theology and the Faculty of Social Sciences certain departments also award A, B, C, D, E or Fail (F). The highest grade is A and the lowest passing grade is E. In a limited number of courses only the grades Pass (G) or Fail (U) are awarded.

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with this agreement, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, which cannot be resolved between programme directors or other designated representatives, will promptly be referred to the persons who is authorized to sign this agreement, or designee, who will address these matters in negotiations and come to a binding agreement between the contracting institutions.
